The Pastor's Pen...

As Thanksgiving approaches this year, it is a difficult season. So many are reeling under the punishing load of storm damage. Lives and livelihoods have been lost on a massive scale. We hurt when we consider how heavy the load of these victims is this Thanksgiving season. On top of that, we are so divided when it comes to government and the direction of our country. Some might even wonder if there's anything for which to be truly thankful this year. Of course there is! If we have been spared from disasters this year and are prosperous enough to help in any way those who are suffering, how thankful we should be that God is allowing us to help. What a great blessing that is this year.

But as believers, let us always remember that the ultimate blessing for which we should be thankful this year is our great salvation. I offer six items which have been called "the accomplishments of the cross." First, there is **justification**. Romans 5:1 says, "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." To be justified means to be declared "not guilty" by God even though we still sin. How could this be? Simply put, Christ took our guilt by taking our sin upon Himself. Second, there is sanctification. Romans 6:22 says, "But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life." This is the present tense of salvation where, through Christ's sacrifice for us, we are constantly being made more like Christ as God sets us apart on an ongoing basis. His blood shed on the cross has not only bore the penalty of our sin but has also broken the power of our sin! Third, there is glorification. Romans 8:30b says, "These whom He justified, He also glorified." Glorification is the future tense of salvation, where we are promised a glorified body one day and a home in heaven. Fourth, there is redemption. Galatians 3:13a says, "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law." Redemption means we were enslaved to the world, the flesh, and the devil. But Christ "purchased us" by His blood shed on the cross. He has set us free! Fifth, there is propitiation. 1 John 2:2a says, "And He (Jesus) is the propitiation for our sins." The word means that Christ bore the wrath of our sins when He died on the cross. Sixth, there is reconciliation. Colossians 1:22a says, "Yet He has now reconciled you in His body of flesh through death." This word means that once we were far from God because of sin, but Jesus saved us and brought us back to the Father. Here's an idea, take each one of these six blessings the week before Thanksgiving and meditate on them, one per day, as Thanksgiving approaches.

Isn't our salvation great? And it isn't our Savior great? Happy Thanksgiving, fellow believers!
