The Pastor's Pen...

During the month of February, we will observe the two "ordinances" of the church: the Lord's Supper and baptism. By ordinance, we mean these are two things that Christ commanded us to do as a church until He comes again. The Lord's Supper is designed to help us remember that Christ gave Himself for us on the cross. Jesus told His disciples to regularly partake of the bread and cup and remember His body and blood offered for us. Nothing else we do could do a better job of focusing our hearts on the work of Christ on the cross in our behalf. We will observe the Lord's Supper on Feb. 2. Every believer should eagerly look forward to participating in the Lord's Supper. And every church member should be thankful that we get to observe it corporately.

The second ordinance is baptism. As Baptists, we believe that baptism is for new believers, an external picture of what happens to us internally when we get saved. When a new believer is baptized, he or she is proclaiming through the act that Jesus died for them on the cross and that He was raised from the dead. Also symbolized in baptism is the wonderful truths that the new believer has "died" to his/her old life and has been given a new start through Christ. That's the symbolism of baptism as the candidate is lowered into the baptismal waters and then raised back up. It is a picture of the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ in our behalf. Several candidates will be baptized on Feb. 16. What a joy it is to observe new believers being baptized. It is our chance to celebrate with them and also to remember our own conversion and baptism.

These two ordinances should be cherished in a local church. I challenge you to come and participate on these two days of Sunday worship. If you are providentially hindered from coming, please consider joining us via our YouTube channel. How wonderful it is to see God at work in our midst. I'm thankful for you all.
